



## Bandhan Money Manager Fund<sup>§</sup>

An open ended debt scheme investing in money market instruments.

For very short term parking of surplus or emergency corpus

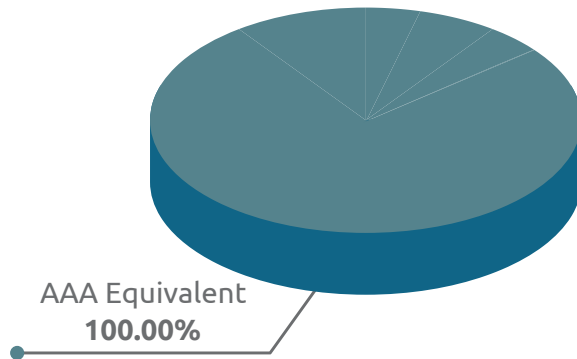
### CORE



